The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) recently released its compiled fire statistics for 2000. NFPA's mission is to reduce the worldwide burden of fire and other hazards on the quality of life by providing and advocating scientifically-based consensus codes and standards, research, training and education.

According to NFPA, a total of 505,000 structure fires and 370,500 residential structure fires occurred in the United States in 2000. One structure fire occurred every 62 seconds, and one residential structure fire occurred every 83 seconds. Nine and a half billion dollars of property damage was caused by residential structure fires. Over 75,000 of the 370,500 residential structure fires were determined to be deliberately set, which was a 4.2 percent increase from the preceding year.

Furthermore, in 2000, there were 348,000 vehicle fires. One vehicle fire occurred every 90 seconds. It was determined that 46,500 vehicle fires were deliberately set. This accounted for 186 million dollars in property damage.

NFPA also determined that the leading causes of accidental fires were: heating equipment (27%); cooking equipment (17%); electrical distribution systems (8%); smoking materials (6.6%); children playing with matches (5%); and natural causes (1.6%).

Only a small percentage of accidental fires were undetermined in cause. This affords an excellent opportunity for insurance companies to obtain full or partial reimbursement of insurance proceeds paid through aggressive subrogation actions. Although all courts recognize the company's legitimate equitable and contractual rights to seek subrogation, more and more, courts are attempting to frustrate access to juries through procedural and legal barriers. Spoilation of evidence, the economic loss doctrine and re-

strictions on product liability prosecutions all serve to create frustrations for the subrogating insurer.

These statistics serve to underline the continuing severity of the fire problem for insurance companies, which is why it is extremely important to be diligent in investigation and ferreting out arson and fraud.

Our staff of experienced subrogation litigators have developed and prosecuted successful subrogation actions throughout the United States. Whether the cause is electrical, mechanical, explosive, collapse or fire spread issues, our attorneys have the background and resources to challenge manufacturers on their own ground. The risk of dangerously defective products causing loss to the insurance industry should not be borne by the insurance company. The only way to effectively prevent this unintended assumption of risk is to aggressively pursue subrogation recoveries whenever possible.
